After careful review of current medical reports such as physician's statements, hospital records, medical consultations or rehab assessments, you may be eligible for a "rated" age.

The medical statement must include:

- § Name
- § Sex
- § Date of Birth
- § History of the illness/injury including date of onset
- § Changes in condition
- § Current Prescription Drugs
- § Relevant current conditions (e.g. coronary disease may be associated with High Blood Pressure of Diabetes)
- § Other significant health conditions (need not be related)
- § Pertinent histories including hospitalizations, surgeries or abnormal lab reports or X-rays.

This underwriting process is unlike life insurance underwriting; medical conditions will *favorably* affect premiums. Reports may be brief; voluminous reports or those with duplicate findings may be counterproductive.
